OCCASIONAL HELP NEEDED:

Accelerated Reader - Through the Accelerated Reader (AR) program, students take tests on books they have read and earn points that can be used in the AR store. Twice a year, AR volunteers assist students in selecting items from the AR store.

Cultural Arts – Help to showcase the artistic talents of our Riverdale students by displaying artwork in the school throughout the year. Also, help the Cultural Arts Manager collect entries for PTO sponsored contests and award participants at the PTO Spring General Meeting and Fine Arts Night.

Hospitality - Help to provide needed items for the PTO general meetings, conference night snacks, events throughout the school year, as well as end of year reception events.

Special Breakfasts - Helpers sell tickets before school in advance of events and/or help serve and assist with set-up/clean-up for 4 annual events: Muffins with Mom, Donuts with Dad, Grandparent's Breakfast, and Boohoo/Yahoo Breakfast.

Yearbook Events Photography - Work with Yearbook Editor to photograph special events throughout the year.

ON-GOING WEEKLY HELP NEEDED:

Art – Help the Riverdale Art Department share all the amazing art created by students. Volunteers are needed to upload student artwork into the Artsonia database, display artwork throughout the building, help complete necessary steps for contest entries, and set-up and oversee students at the Winter Market.

Library - Lots of volunteers are needed to help in the school library by shelving books before school, helping at the Book Fair, decorating for special events, and doing other tasks as needed.

SPECIAL EVENTS – FALL

Fall Fundraiser - This year's fall fundraiser will be Boosterthon. Volunteers are needed to count money, distribute prizes, and help the day of the event. This will take place during the month of November.

SPECIAL EVENTS – SPRING

Dodgeball - Come join the fun! We need help with ticket sales, concessions, refereeing, etc. Student Participants are 5th – 8th grade and all other grades are welcome to attend as spectators.
